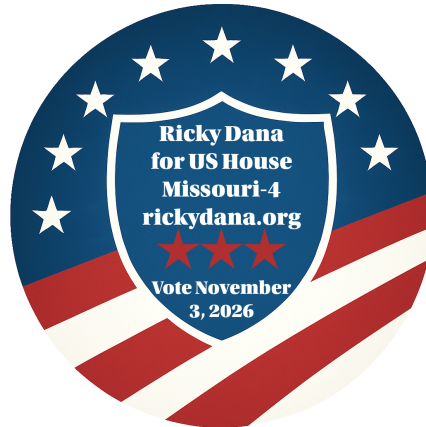
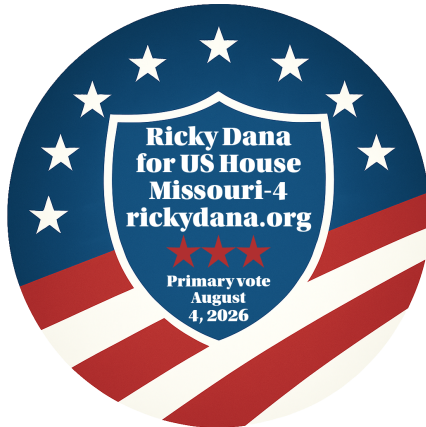


Ricky Dana for U.S. House – Missouri’s 4th District
